1707 **Public Speaking**

a) Members of the public – Council were informed that an Environmental Health update notice for Enthoven has been found dated June 2020 which gives notices of variations and consolidations in a very readable layout. The document will be circulated to all present.

b) PDNPA Member Kath Potter and PCSO B Morris sent apologies.
District Councillor Matthew Buckler asked council to reinforce its submission to the PSPO enquiry to get Stanton Moor included. Council also promised to copy him in on the Enthoven response. He confirmed that the rumoured proposal to make Derbyshire Dales smokeless hasn't officially reached him.

iii) **Planning updates/issues:**

Tonnage sheets have been received as work has restarted at New Pilhough.

Quarry planning conditions – a letter to DCC regarding the annual survey and maintenance of the quarry routes was agreed to be sent including a paragraph on the major areas needing attention on the route that this money can be used for.

Response to DDDC comments regarding all the queries raised last year is being sent shortly following wording alterations in light of the document presented in Public Speaking.

1711 Footpaths and Highways

Footpath No.4 – no update received. Crossroads still not repaired. The Stand – no news. Council has 2 litter pickers currently loaned out to volunteer litter pickers. Our grit bins have been topped up and a further 20 bags are being ordered for collection by the Chair. The photo of the iced bend at the foot of Stanton was sent to DCC and a grit heap has appeared at that point. Lees Road continues to fall away in the rains. A request will be put in Snail asking drivers not to park on the pavements in Stanton in Peak. Loose stones at the road edge by the war memorial need reporting.

1712 Reports and Decisions

i. The Green / Parish assets

The Green –Fisher German have yet to come back following acceptance of our requirement for continued use. The new noticeboard for Stanton in Peak is being priced.

ii. PDNPA Stanton Moor Solstice future

The frustrations of other parties seeming weighed down in discussion not action was noted. Council agreed to pursue the addition of Stanton Moor to the register of Public Space Protection Orders to give powers that don't need landowner involvement to remove offenders. There is still debris and leftovers from the Winter Solstice littering the Moor. No meeting date has yet been set for the liaison meeting.

iii. Enthoven – HGVs

DCCllr Atkin reports that Enthoven are trying to get Highways to put double yellow lines along both sides of the road from Darley Bridge to stop lorries parking on the approaches.

iv. Letter to MP supporting PDNPA funding

Agreed to write to Sarah Dines asking her to support core funding increases to enable PDNPA to maintain its work.

v. Snail Subscription
